Clothing volunteers are needed for the following days and time slots:

Tuesdays (between 9:30am and 2pm)
Wednesdays (between 11:30am and 4pm)
3rd Thursdays (currently, we open on one Thursday each month, Noon - 4pm)

We also have a need for a pair of Individual **Home Delivery drivers on the 3rd Wednesday** of each month, between Noon and 3pm. Drivers deliver food boxes to homebound individuals in their personal vehicles, and are required to deliver alongside a partner.
